

v. Nature and Extent of Involvement of Faculties and Students in Academic Affairs and Improvements

Initiatives taken to inculcate the spirit of research amongst faculty and students are as follows: Following research policy was framed.

- Financial assistance is provided for publications
- Facilities such as flexibility in timings, use of laboratories etc are extended to faculty as per requirement
- Implementing a policy for distribution of Testing and Consultancy charges to motivate faculty for providing consultancy
- Faculties with an aptitude for research are identified. Seed money is provided to young faculty to implement their research project. More experienced faculty are encouraged to apply and obtain research grants from various Government and non- Government, research funding agencies such as UGC, DST, AICTE, RGSTC, SPPU (BCUD) etc.

Community engagement - Extra Curricular Activities

 The institute believes that we have a responsibility towards society and that technology should be brought to the use of community. National Social Service (NSS) activities make students responsible towards society, environment, global issues, etc and develop into responsible citizens.

vi. Mechanism / Norms And Procedure For Democratic/Good Governance

The management recognizes the need for decentralization for the growth of the institute and accords autonomy commensurate with the level of management. Deans and heads are appointed who are given autonomy for efficient governance.

The roles and responsibilities of administrators / decision makers for various assigned jobs listed

below clearly depict the delegation of authority, providing operational autonomy leading to a decentralized governance system.

Principal

To implement and monitor the education system to cater to the institute's vision and mission.

Head of the department

Is responsible for the academic and administrative functions of the department.

In addition, Registrar, Accounts Officer, Librarian, Workshop Superintendent take care of office related activities, finance related issues, library resources and workshop related activities. Other support functions are handled by the Admission-in-charge, NBA Coordinator, NAAC Coordinator, College Examination Officer, Industry Institute Interaction Cell Coordinator and NSS coordinator.

At the department level:

- 1. Each program has UG and PG coordinators
- 2. Preparation of academic calendar based on time frame set by the college for planning and organizing of activities is done by Time Table coordinator
- 3. Each course has a course coordinator who, in consultation with the faculty teaching the subject, sets course objectives, prepares the teaching plan for the semester, conducts meetings with faculty regularly to monitor and review course completion and attainment of course outcomes and submits a report of the same to coordinator.
- 4. Class teachers/batch guardians are designated for all classes/batches

vii. Student Feedback On Institutional Governance / Faculty Performance

The college has a well-established feedback system that aims at improving the teaching learning process and provides a continuous support to students for their all-round development.

They are:

- 1. Course Monitoring
- 2. Course exit survey
- 3. Information from mentors
- 4. Interaction of the Head of the Dept.
- 5. Graduate Exit Survey
- 6. Alumni opinion
- 7. Parents meeting

1. Course Monitoring

Course monitoring is an exercise to check with students during the semester to obtain feedback from students in the class about any problems in instruction and coverage of syllabus in each course, and also about any other problems in facilities like canteen, library etc.

The committee consisting of HOD and a senior faculty member visit each class, once after 6 weeks after start of the semester and in the 11 or 12th week to get the feedback. Students are asked if they feel that instruction is not satisfactory in any subjects, and to mention the specific problems. Opinion of students regarding faculty in terms of percentage is also taken in those subjects. General opinion on facilities like library, canteen is also obtained in each visit.

Action: In the first visit, if most of the students opine that instruction is poor in one or more subjects, HOD issues a letter to the concerned teacher about the feedback and emphasizes the need to improve in specific areas. HOD gathers opinion of students after 5 or 6 periods. If students are still not satisfied, the teacher is changed for that subject.

After each visit, teachers with unsatisfactory feedback are counseled. If the complaint is of a minor nature like audibility or solving only a few problems etc., the teachers are counseled. If instruction is poor, a letter is issued mentioning the aspects to improve. For problems regarding facilities, HOD brings to the notice of the in charge of the facility or Principal when necessary.

2. Course exit survey:

At the end of each semester, a course exit survey is conducted for each course on students opinion of attainment of the COs. Results of this survey are communicated to the teachers so that they make efforts towards better attainment.

The course exit survey is collected through online.

3. Mentors feedback:

Mentors provide feedback to HOD after each counseling. When necessary, class coordinator arranges extra coaching to needy students.

4. Interaction of the Head of the Dept.:

HOD meets student groups on various occasions and collects feedback on academic and other issues of students.

5. Graduate Exit Survey:

Survey is conducted for outgoing students to get feedback on attainment of POs and PSOs, and to seek opinion on academics, facilities and co and extra-curricular activities.

6. Alumni opinion:

Is obtained from visiting alumni and also on mail, regarding feedback on POs/ PSOs and suggestions on improving curriculum.

7. Feedback on facilities

Students are asked to give feedback on facilities by the mentors, who in turn report the same to the Head of the Dept. HOD directly takes up the redresses with the in charges of the concerned facility or reports to Principal where necessary.

Students Feedback and action: Feedback from students is collected by survey at the end of the year. Interaction of HOD and Course monitoring committee also provide the feedback during each semester. **Initiation of Action:** HOD and senior faculty interact with students to find out specific reasons in the cases where 50% or more stated Poor and Satisfactory. Action is initiated for improvement of these facilities, by HOD or senior faculty contacting the concerned facility in charge or the Principal if necessary.

16. Best Practices adopted, if any

Best Practice - I: Academic Calendar

A detailed academic calendar is prepared at the beginning of every academic year and adhered to it that
include the academic sessions with internal assessment test and practical examination.

Best Practice - II: Orientation Programme

- Orientation programmes for first year students are conducted for three to four weeks at the beginning of
 every academic year. The students are made aware of the College Vision, Mission and the value system
 and ethics to be followed. Special emphasis is given to enhance the communication skills to the. They are
 familiarized with the Laboratory and other facilities. They are introduced to the Library services including
 digital library. They get familiarized with the faculty member and office staff.
- The lateral entry students who directly join the second year of the program are also given orientation for a brief period as they join after the academic session began. However, bridge courses to them are conducted after class hours without disturbing the regular course work.

Best Practice - III: Curriculum Development

- A Comprehensive development of curriculum for all the autonomous programs is carried out based on the
 Program revision policy of the College. Benchmarking of the programmes with reputed international and
 national Institutes is carried out by a Program Benchmarking team with the approval of the Benchmarking
 Institutes by the HODs Committee. This report along with the feedback from stakeholders and the new
 developments in the field scanned by the faculty are used to revise the curriculum. The curriculum is then
 approved by the respective Board of study and the College Academic Council.
- The Choice Based Credit system for all the autonomous programmes of study. MOOC course is made compulsory.

Best Practice – IV: Preparation of Course Plan and communicating to students

• Every teacher prepares/reviews the course plan before the commencement of the semester which is mapping of week-wise topic to be taught with the intended learning outcomes, teaching methods, assessment methods and the date(s) of submission/written examination. It also includes the scheme of evaluation giving the details of assessment method, type/mode of questions, weightage of marks, and date of submission/examination. It also includes the self-evaluation questions. This is communicated to the students at the beginning of the semester.

Best Practice - V: Peer review of Course Plan

The course plan prepared by the concerned teacher is reviewed by another teacher who has taught the course before and prepares the Report in the Template given in Teaching Learning Policy and submits to the Head of the Department. The teacher is asked to revise the plan as per suggestions given in the Report and submit the final version to the Head of the Department. This ensures the complete preparation of the pan in all respects, the coverage of the entire syllabus, and all the ILOs. It also ensures the selection of appropriate teaching and Assessment methods, appropriateness of the teaching and assessment methods and the scheme of assessment.

Best Practice – VI: Monitoring the course delivery

• Class coordination committees of each class meet once every month to discuss the status of syllabus coverage, continuous evaluation, discipline problems, if any, nonperforming students, students with chronic absenteeism etc. They also take up corrective actions and these are reviewed by the department committee and also by the academic monitoring team. They plan the remedial classes where necessary.

Best Practice – VII: Verification of Question papers

- The Internal Assessment Test and End Semester Examination question papers are peer reviewed for the easy/toughness of questions, appropriate weightage of marks to the question. The examiner must submit the scheme of valuation along with the question paper. The reviewer verifies the appropriateness of the answers or brief note of valuation. The Reviewer submits a report in the Template given in the Assessment and Evaluation Policy of the College to the Examiner who revises based on the suggestions. The End Semester Examination question paper is also subjected to the external review before the Examination along with the Scheme of valuation.
- The reviewers, both internal and external, reviews a sample of answer scripts of the mid-term tests and the End Semester Examination for the uniform evaluation and the completion of evaluation in all respects. They also look into the bias, fairness and correctness.

Best Practice - VIII: Distribution of evaluated answer scripts to students for scrutiny

• The evaluation schemes are placed on the website for the students to evaluate themselves. The answer scripts, after the evaluation of all the assessments are shown to the students including the semester end examination. The student can check the valuation as per the scheme. Any deviation of the actual evaluation from the scheme can be reported to the subject teacher so that the claims made by the student can be considered and the paper is reevaluated as per the claims without any fee. This is a measure taken as part of the transparency in the evaluation system.

Best Practice – IX: UG Internship and final Project

Provision is made for industry based projects where the students can work in the Company for four to five
months for their project. Students are allowed to take MOOC courses of the equivalent subjects of the
final semester with the approval of the Department. Internship is made mandatory and a credit course in
the R2020 regulations and the Department make proactive special efforts to get the students internship
opportunities.

Best Practice – X: Mentoring system

• The mentoring system is designed to assist the students in academic and general issues they face during the four year period of the degree. A faculty member is assigned as a mentor for a group of 15 to 20

students in the first year itself. The same mentor may continue with the group till the final year. The mentoring is conducted in a structured way. The mentor and the students meet at least one hour in every week as per the schedule in the time table. The mentor counsels the students in not only the issues related academics but also some of their personal issues and a proper guidance and support is provided to ensure the comfort of the students in the campus. In the cases where advanced counseling is needed, the student is referred to the psychological counselor. The mentors also participate in the class review meetings and discuss about the students with the teachers of the class.

Best Practice – XI: Assistance to special category Students

 College formed the SC/ST Committee, OBC committee, and the women welfare committee to assist the students in getting assistance through Central and State Government schemes, to provide skills training, and in any specific issues.

Best Practice - XII: Innovation, Incubation and Entrepreneurship

- The Centre for Innovation, Incubation and Entrepreneurship of the College organizes training programmes, workshops and Seminars on innovation and idea generation. College has started incubation activities where the students are provided space as needed and encouraged to utilize all the facilities, equipment and software, of the College to develop the idea into a product/service.
- The College also makes special efforts to get the students mentored for innovation and entrepreneurship. Forty students have been chosen by ten entrepreneurs to mentor the students for innovation and entrepreneurship during the current academic year.
- Entrepreneurship is introduced as a chapter in a core subject and special lectures/workshops are arranged on entrepreneurship
