## **Proceedings:**

#### The following points were discussed:

- The coordinator is introducing the new members of the women's complaint and redressal cell and is extending a warm welcome to everyone.
- Government of India has allocated short code 181 to Tamil Nadu as Women Helpline. Women Helpline is intended to provide 24 hours immediate and emergency response to women affected by violence through referral (linking with appropriate authority As Police, OSC, Hospitals, etc.,) and information about women related government schemes programs across the country through a single uniform number.

- Women Helpline (WHL) established in Tamil Nadu to provide integrated support and assistance to women affected by violence, both in private and public spaces under one roof. Women Helpline also provides Guidance and counseling services to needy women and at present functioning at Amtex Towers, SIPCOT Industrial Estate, Siruseri, Chennai.
- Coordinator elucidates the importance of the Kavalan SOS Mobile App which is managed by a Tamilnadu Police Department.
- The girl students were advised not to entertain any phone calls regarding the opening of the college until an official circular is intimated to them.
- Students requested suggestions to maintain a cordial relationship with each other and to overcome peer pressure.
- The Coordinator asked to regard measures to be taken in the previous years. It was decided to promote measures aimed at achieving gender equality, removal of gender bias or discrimination, sexual harassment and other acts of gender based violence in the college, since the college is a co-educational, hence safety and security to the girl students should be given priority.
- A provision is made in such a way that the girl students can complaint through SMS to the coordinator of the committee
- Helpline numbers of the coordinator is circulated to the students to make use of it during emergency
- The Coordinator asked to organize awareness programs and campaigns for the benefit of all members of the College on sexual harassment and gender based discrimination.
- The principal was happy to announce that there had never been a case of gender discrimination at our college in the previous years.
